RESEARCH GRANT PROGRAM

Our Research Grant Program provides funding to researchers who share our goal of developing new therapies that have the potential to transform the lives of people living with blindness and vision loss.

Clinical trials depend on the successful recruitment of patient volunteers. FBC's Patient Registry helps facilitate that process by providing registrants with the latest information on emerging clinical trials and giving them the opportunity to volunteer as trial participants. The Patient Registry informs FBC's ability to communicate with government, industry, and community stakeholders about the need for new treatments in Canada by offering verified information about the number of people who would benefit from new treatments.

CLINICIAN-SCIENTIST Emerging leader awards

Strengthening patient outcomes by linking discovery research to clinical care.

Clinician-scientists bridge the gap between the fields of scientific research and clinical medicine, honing their abilities not only as researchers dedicated to understanding the fundamentals of disease and why it occurs, but also as clinicians working directly with patients. Clinician-scientists play an essential role in transforming pre-clinical research into clinical trials, new treatments, and improved patient outcomes—however, only a handful of clinician-scientists in Canada are practicing in the field of ophthalmology. By providing research funds and mentorship opportunities to the next generation of clinician-scientist ophthalmologists, sponsors of our award are directly shaping the future of vision research, treatment, and care in Canada.

TRANSFORMATIVE RESEARCH AWARDS

Funding strategic areas of need within vision research.

The Transformative Research Award (TRA) program funds strategic areas of need within vision research. The goal is to provide significant investment for innovative and ambitious research to drive the development of treatments for blinding eye diseases. The Restore Vision 20/20 fund is an example of this approach. With the incredible support of Donna Green, Goldie Feldman and an anonymous donor, Fighting Blindness Canada invested \$2.5 million into projects that remove the final barriers of moving lab discoveries through clinical trials and into new treatments. New TRA are being launched to repeat our Restore Vision 20/20 success. Researchers from around the world can apply for up to \$1.25 million over 5 years.

At Fighting Blindness Canada, we want to ensure individuals living with or affected by vision loss are receiving clear and understandable information which enables them to better engage with their health and have more insightful conversations with their health care provider. Our Health Information web pages provide relevant and accurate information on symptoms, diagnosis, and treatments for common eye diseases as well as more detailed information about innovative treatments and clinical trials. To complement this and provide one on one support, FBC runs a Health Information Line. This service, reached by phone or email, provides answers to questions about eye health and treatment.

As Canada's largest charitable funder of vision research, FBC provides critical funding to a diverse portfolio of multi-year projects at universities and hospitals across Canada and internationally. Drawing on the medical expertise of our Scientific Advisory Board, combined with our Mission Investment Steering Committee's robust investment management strategies, FBC's Board of Directors can ensure that the organization not only funds the best, most promising research into blinding eye diseases, but that those funded projects have the best chance of becoming treatments and cures for Canadians.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Fighting Blindness Canada's volunteer Board of Directors is led by those who have lived experience with vision loss. Committed to leading the fight against blindness, the Board of Directors is comprised of individuals with a wide range of expertise and is strategically leading FBC in its mission to accelerate the availability of treatments and cures for blinding eye diseases.

SCIENTIFIC ADVISORY BOARD

Comprised of internationally renowned vision scientists, FBC's Scientific Advisory Board (SAB) reviews every funding proposal and research application submitted to FBC to ensure that it meets the highest standards of scientific merit.

Rigorous review by the SAB ensures that funds donated to FBC are used to fuel the most productive and promising research projects that address crucial questions about the causes for blinding eye diseases and tackles the challenge of finding treatments and cures. The SAB provides counsel on milestones in each research grant to ensure that FBC can properly evaluate each project's progress.

In 2019, three out of five international awards for vision research went to members of our Scientific Advisory Board.

MISSION INVESTMENT STEERING COMMITTEE

FBC's Mission Investment Steering Committee (MISC) provides robust investment management and advisory counsel to FBC. Comprised of leading advisors with expertise in translational research, commercialization, intellectual property, and venture capital investing, the MISC enables FBC to maximize its research impact and fund research projects that have the greatest potential to become new treatments for blinding eye diseases.
